## ADMINISTRATOR FERRO NOMINATION PROCESS TIMELINE

*Did The Obama Administration Cut A "Deal" With The Teamsters To Change The Hours Of Service Rules?*

- 6/4/09 – President Obama nominates Anne Ferro, head of The Maryland Trucking Association, to be the Administrator of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration.
- 6/5/09 - Teamsters Union President James Hoffa writes to President Obama objecting to nomination based on Ferro's past support for the hours of service rules.
- 9/23/09 - Senate Commerce Committee holds confirmation hearing. Chairman Lautenberg strongly objects over Ferro's historical support for the hours of service rule.
- 9/24/09 -10/25/09 – Senate Commerce Committee confirmation vote held up.
- 10/26/09 - Hours of Service settlement agreement with Teamsters signed.
- 10/27/09 - Senate Commerce committee votes to approve Ferro's nomination and forwards recommendation to full Senate.
